Open Snocross Practice is on at Extreme Motor Park in Elk River, Minnesota

MINNEAPOLIS (November 21, 2008); Extreme Motor Park (ERX) in Elk River, Minnesota is open for practice. The newly created motorsports facility located just off Highway 169 on the outskirts of the Twin Cities has been making snow for more than a week and is now open for snocross as the first National race of season in Duluth, Minnesota lurks just one week away.

With three snow guns and two groomers on site, the staff at ERX has been working around the clock blowing snow and building a world class snocross track in preparation for the facility's inaugural season. Early this week, the park opened its gates, giving riders a chance to tune their snowmobiles and hone their snocross skills prior to the start of the competitive season.

"Thanks to the cold temperatures we've been making snow each and every night for the past week," said Chris Carlson, co-owner of the ERX facility. "At one time we had more than 12 feet of snow piled up on various portions of the track and each day the crew at ERX builds the track during the morning hours.

Not only does ERX provide some the best snocross riding opportunities anywhere, but does so with perhaps the most convenient location too. "Before ERX you either had to know someone with a private track or drive several hours north to practice," said Carlson. "ERX will make it much easier and more affordable for riders to get seat time all season long."



Open practice at the track runs from noon to 5:00pm now through Wednesday, November 24th, and will be open every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday throughout the winter season. Participation fee is just \$75 per day or \$50 for riders 16 and under. Season passes are also available. Each day the track is knocked down at the close of practice and reconstructed the following morning to keep conditions the best possible. Riders of every skill level are invited and safety equipment such as upper body protection, helmet and an operational tether are required.

Six events are currently slated for ERX this winter, with more on-deck as well as a summer schedule to be announced later this winter. ERX will also be available for private uses such as factory team testing, special dealer demo events, test rides, training and safety classes, swap meets, club functions and more.
